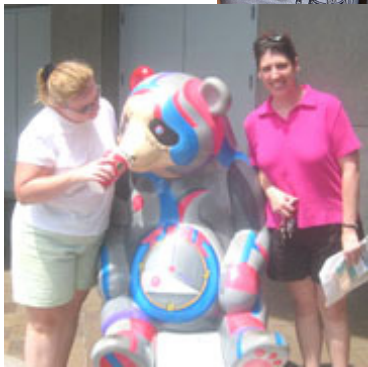


Why join?

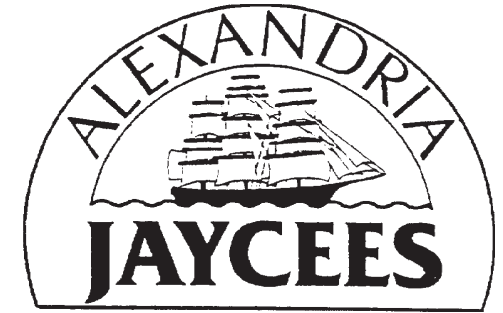
